

Reconciling Allergy Lists for eHana/Rcopia

Because our clients are often seen at more than one Eliot facility and may have doctors outside Eliot, a client's PIF may have information imported from Rcopia in the Comments section that duplicates/adds to the information in the structured list.

The solution is to open a new allergy form under Client Tasks, and then add allergies listed in the Comments section to the structured list so that Rcopia will flag possible interactions.

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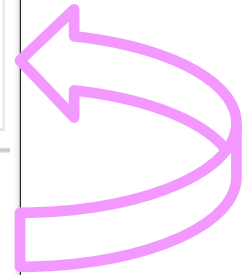


Figure 1 Unreconciled Allergy List

Adding/Editing Allergies

Allergies can be added as part of other forms that include the structured allergies field.

- a. Client Personal Information Form (PIF).
- b. Adult and Child Comprehensive Assessments (CA)
- c. Physical Health Assessment
- d. Psychiatric Evaluation
- e. Nursing SNA
- f. Psychopharm Note

A second way to add allergies is through a stand-alone form found on the Med Dashboard, under Client Tasks. Open a client's record, and then click the Med Dashboard tab.

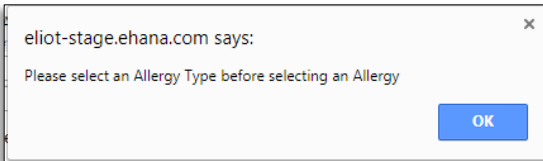
